H1N1 Vaccinations on Walk-in Basis

H1N1 influenza vaccination is now available through the regular clinic at the Monroe County Health Department. Clients are served on a walk-in basis, no appointments necessary. Clinic hours are Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 9:00 – 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 – 4:00 p.m. Evening clinic hours are available until 6:00 p.m. on the first and third Wednesday of every month. Please note there are no clinic hours on Thursdays. The H1N1 vaccine is FREE of charge to all.

H1N1 Vaccine is now available to all individuals (age 6 months and older) who wish to be protected against the virus. It's a good time to get vaccinated. Good infection control practice is important to decreasing the spread of illness so remember to wash your hands frequently, cover your face with a tissue when you cough or sneeze, and stay home if you are ill.
